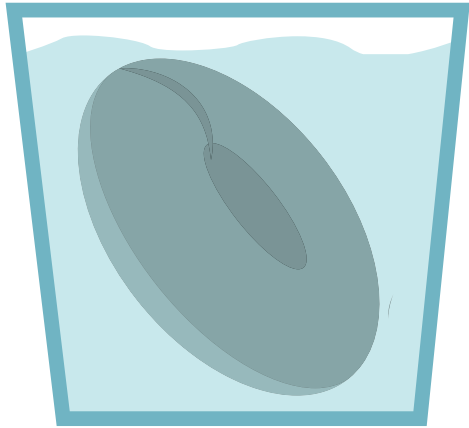


Instructions

PREFERRED METHOD TO FILL UP TREEDIAPER



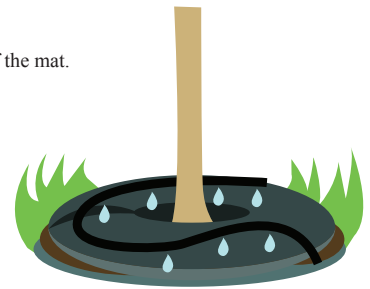
1. Place the TreeDiaper® product completely submerged in water in a sink or bucket for at least 5 hours or overnight.

NOTE:

- Covering with mulch, pine needles, or leaves is recommended.
- Do not place any soil, dirt, fine sand, compost, or iron-based sticks or tomato cage on top of TreeDiaper® products. This may result in the loss of functionalities of TreeDiaper® products.
- Direct contact of fertilizers with the material in use or in storage may temporarily or permanently affect the performance of the product.
- Do not poke TreeDiaper® products with sticks. Damage to the surface integrity of the TreeDiaper® products may decrease functionality of the product.

CAN BE REFILLED WITH IRRIGATION SYSTEMS

Let drip irrigation water the top of the mat.



SECONDARY METHOD TO FILL TREEDIAPER

WHEN 3 OR MORE INCHES OF RAIN IS EXPECTED IN THE NEXT 30 DAYS.

WILL ABSORB RAINWATER OR IRRIGATION WATER



1. Place the TreeDiaper® product on top of soil around plants. Make sure the pellets inside the TreeDiaper® product are evenly distributed.



2. (Recommended, but optional) Cover with 2" of mulch to disguise and protect the TreeDiaper® product. **Do not cover with soil.** Landscaping staples can be used in a high wind region.



3. Water trees if wilting or yellow leaves appear or once every three to four (3-4) weeks if less than 1" of rainfall during that period.
